

RMC Legislative Committee Meeting Minutes

Legislative Committee Co-chair Lindsay Thompson welcomed everyone and convened the meeting at 2:03pm. Committee members introduced themselves via the chat feature.

Ms. Charlotte Davis provided an update on HB695 - Rural Maryland Prosperity Investment Fund — Revisions and Sunset Repeal (Rural Communities Improvement Act of 2023). Ms. Davis stated that the bill hearing was held on Friday, February 24, 2023 and the sponsor feels pretty adamant that it will get out of the Committee. Ms. Davis reported that there was also a hearing for HB596/SB511 — Health and Human Services Transportation Improvement Act of 2023. The hearing for the Senate was held on 2/22 and the House hearing is on 2/28. Ms. Davis is meeting with Senator Hettleman to discuss the bill. Mr. Steve McHenry stated that there appeared to be confusion with the \$1 million mandate relevant to the money RMC was receiving and he suggested that staff emphasize that the Council is getting a lot of money and not worry about the million dollars. Mr. McHenry stated that there is a new \$100,000 mandatory money cap in the House — no new spending above \$100,000.

Jamar Day, Child Care and ECE Policy Champion provided background and asked for the Committee to support SB495/HB868: Child Care Provider Stabilization Program – Established. This bill establishes the establishes the Child Care Provider Stabilization Program within the Maryland State Department of Education (MSDE) to provide "stability funding" to eligible child care providers in the State. The Committee stated they would support the bill.

Ms. Charlotte Davis provided an update on the Maryland Day event that will be held on March 24, 2023. The Committee decided that the Executive Board and Legislative Committee should be invited to the event.
